PPPL Kicks Off United Way Campaign

On Tuesday, December 4, PPPL will host the annual United Way meeting for employees at 10:30 A.M. in the MBG Auditorium. This meeting will provide information about United Way programs, and will feature a video, speakers, refreshments, and door prizes (see page 2). The prizes have been donated by employees and local merchants. Everyone who attends the meeting is eligible for the door prizes drawn and also will receive a patriotic (red, white, and blue) water bottle. In addition, those who contribute to this year's campaign will be entered in the Grand Prize Drawing for a \$300 gift certificate for travel arrangements, compliments of PPPL. The Grand Prize will be drawn on Wednesday, December 12, at noon in the LSB Lobby.

The United Way of Greater Mercer County provides grants to 124 programs at 65 agencies to meet our community's most pressing needs. It is at the forefront of building partnerships, forging consensus, and maximizing resources to address critical needs in our community. Funds donated to the United Way go directly to programs that strengthen families, build self-sufficiency, promote health and well-being, and respond to crises. In essence, the agency is a "community solutions provider."

Pledge Cards

Staff have received pledge cards in the interoffice mail. These forms can be dropped off at the close of the meeting on December 4 or mailed to 2001 PPPL United Way Chairperson Mary Ann Brown at MS-38. Donations may be given as a one-time contribution or through payroll deductions. For every dollar you give through payroll deduction, Princeton University will donate an additional 15 cents, and for donations made by cash or check, the university will contribute 10 cents for every dollar. Contributors may also earmark which charities they would like their donations to fund (Charities are listed in your pledge card envelope material). In addition, employees

will have the opportunity this year to give to the September 11th Fund to aid victims and families of those affected by the recent tragedy. There is a separate card in the United Way packet explaining how you can contribute to this.

"The Laboratory has always been a strong supporter of the United Way. In addition to supporting the World Trade Center disaster, I hope we can continue our excellent standard of giving to our local agencies," said Mary Ann Brown.

Please give generously. By donating just \$1 per week, you could provide two nights in a shelter for a homeless family of four; \$5 per week means five months of dinner meals for a senior citizen; \$10 per week gives the basic necessities for a family of six who are victims of a fire; and \$20 per week provides 15 days in a shelter with counseling for a battered woman and her children. ●
