Brighten Someone's Life through United Way

On Tuesday, December 10, PPPL is hosting the annual United Way meeting for employees at 10 A.M. in the MBG Auditorium. This meeting will provide information about United Way programs, and will feature a video, speakers, refreshments, and door prizes (see list of prizes on page 2). The prizes have been donated by employees and local merchants. Everyone who attends the meeting is eligible for the door prizes drawn and also will receive a key-ring light. The first 50 to enter the meeting will receive a special key-ring light that includes a valet ring. In addition, those who contribute to this year's campaign will be entered in the Grand Prize Drawing for a \$300 gift certificate for travel arrangements, compliments of PPPL. The Grand Prize will be drawn on Wednesday, December 18, at noon in the LSB Lobby.

Pledge Cards

Prior to the meeting staff will receive pledge cards in the interoffice mail. These forms can be dropped off at the meeting or mailed to 2002 PPPL United Way Chairperson Mary Ann Brown at MS-38. Donations may be given as a one-time contribution or through payroll deductions. For every dollar you give through payroll deduction, Princeton University will donate an additional 15 cents, and for donations made by cash or check, the University will contribute 10 cents for every dollar. Contributors may also earmark which charities they would like their donations to fund (Charities are listed in your pledge card envelope material).

The United Way of Greater Mercer County provides grants to 121 programs at local agencies in four focus areas — strengthening families, building self-sufficiency, promoting health and well-being, and responding to crises. But it is more than a fundraiser, the agency is a “community solutions provider.” A single gift to United Way enables a donor to support many important health and human services issues from child care to elder care, services to people with AIDS and other illnesses, disaster relief, after-school services, literacy training, and much more. By pledging \$100 (just \$8.34 each month through payroll deduction), you could provide 18 hot nutritious

Examples of what your dollars could provide:

- \$1 per week — Emergency food to feed 10 families of four for four days.
- \$5 per week — Five months of dinner meals for a senior citizen.
- \$10 per week — A hot, nutritious meal for 100 homeless, indigent people.
- \$20 a week — 15 days in a shelter with counseling for a battered woman and her children

meals to seniors and the disabled who are homebound, food and/or diapers for a week for an infant who is in temporary foster care, or three days of job training for a mother on welfare who needs support to become self-sufficient.
