What Matters: Results You can See United Way Campaign

PPPPL, the University, and other employers in the area will join together to help people in the local communities through the United Way of Greater Mercer County's annual fund-raising campaign. This year's theme is "What Matters: Results You Can See." On Wednesday, December 8, PPPL is hosting the annual United Way meeting for employees at 10:30 A.M. in the MBG Auditorium. This meeting will provide information about United Way programs and will feature a presentation by Better Beginnings Daycare Center Executive Director Luz Horta, refreshments, and a tricky-tray raffle (see list of prizes on page 2). The raffle prizes have been donated by the Lab, employees, and local merchants. Everyone who attends the meeting is eligible for prizes. Those who contribute to this year's campaign will be entered in the Grand Prize drawings, which will occur at the PPPL Holiday Party on Thursday, December 23, in the LSB Lobby at noon (see list of Grand Prizes on page 2).

Donations may be given as a one-time contribution or through payroll deductions. The University will contribute 15 cents per dollar for all gifts made by payroll deduction. For all other types of donations, the University will contribute 10 cents per dollar.

All donations will be distributed to United Way programs in Mercer County or employees' home communities or to other health and human services agencies that are designated by individual donors. United Way funding is based on three focus areas — promoting health and well-being, responding to crisis, and strengthening individuals and families.

Donors can choose to make general or specific contributions. They can provide contributions that are divided among all United Way-supported programs, among all programs in an area of interest, or among all except for a particular program. With a minimum gift of \$52, they can designate a contribution to a United Way in their home community, to any specific program supported by the United Way or to any charitable health or human care organization with a 5013c tax status that is not supported by the United Way. While the historic focus of United Way is on home communities, it also is possible to direct gifts to agencies that provide health or human care in other countries. (Charities are listed in your pledge card envelope material.) **Please give generously.**

****NEW:** This year the raffle prizes at the December 8 meeting will be drawn through a tricky-tray method. You will be given a ticket upon entering the Auditorium to place into a bag labeled with the prize of your choice. The prizes to select from are listed on page 2.
