Career Workshops a Hit

Approximately 30 Laboratory employees from the six PPPL staffs participated in the Career Planning and Development Workshop held on 7-8 June. An introductory session for selected managers and supervisors was held on June 6th. The purpose of this session was to acquaint supervisors with the program as well as to provide insight into the process.

According to Elizabeth Moir, Manager of Training and Organizational Development at the Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory (LLNL), participation by an employee's manager or supervisor is important to the overall level of understanding and support needed to insure continuing success of the program. "Career planning is not a product in itself," she said, "but it is a process that makes a contribution to the overall quality of the work at PPPL.

"Our intent is to design the workshops so that employees and managers can both determine the best job fit and how to find the most productive application of talents."

Workshops Tailored

Marianne Clark, Staff Development Specialist and responsible for Career Development Workshops at LLNL, took the primary role in leading the pilot sessions here.
